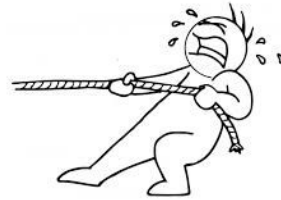


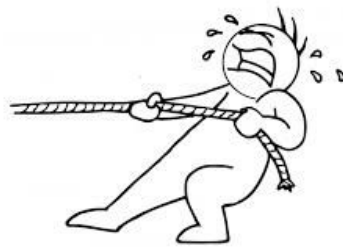
Force:

pushes or pulls on objects that causes them to move



Push:

using force to move something away from you



Pull:

using force to move something towards you

Motion:

when objects move from place to place



Gravity:

a force (pull) that affects movements of objects on or near Earth



Fast:

moving at high speed; quick



Slow:

moving at low speed; sluggish



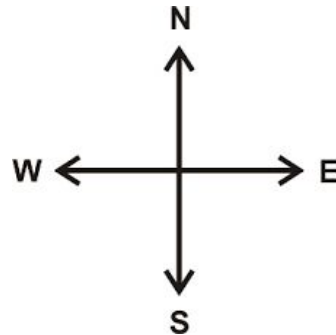
Speed:

Direction:

a place where something moves or faces



Distance:

amount of space
between two things



Time:

hours and minutes;
how long something
can take



Travel:

go from one

another



Transfer:

move from one
thing to another



Object:

something that can be
seen or touched

Friction:

rubbing objects together



Parachute:

a cloth that holds someone in the air
